

PUBLIC NOTICE

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as Amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions Act) 1991

Carmarthenshire County Council hereby gives notice that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along that length of road known as B4310 Brechfa, from a point 2.3 kilometres north-east of its junction with the C2052, for a distance of 480 metres in a north-easterly direction.

The closure is necessary to ensure public safety whilst Welsh Water repair a leaking pipe, which shall take place on 9th June 2024 from 09:30 to 15:30.

The alternative route for south-west bound traffic will be to proceed in a north-easterly direction along the B4310, passing through Abergorlech village, to its junction with the B4337. At the junction, turn left and continue in a north-westerly direction along the B4337, passing through Rhydcymerau village and entering Llanybydder, to its junction with the A485. At the junction, turn left and continue in a south-westerly direction along the A485, passing through Llanllwni, Alltwalis and Rhydargaeau, to the Dolgwili Roundabout. At the roundabout, take the first exit and continue along the A485 in a south-easterly direction to the roundabout. At the roundabout, take the first exit and continue along the A40 in a south-easterly direction to the roundabout. At the roundabout, take second exit and continue along the A40 in a north-easterly direction, passing through Nantgaredig, to its junction with the B4310. At the junction, turn left and continue in a north-easterly direction, passing through Horeb and Brechfa, to return to a point south-west of the closure. Vice versa for north-east bound traffic.

Pedestrian movement to individual properties will be maintained where possible throughout the duration of the closure.
