

PUBLIC NOTICE

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as Amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions Act) 1991

Carmarthenshire County Council hereby gives notice that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along that length of road known as the C2157 Rhandirmwyn from a point 295 metres south west of its junction with the U4180 Royal Oak Road for a total distance of 422 metres in a south westerly direction.

The closure is necessary for Openreach (Peter Evans – 07930 085070) to carry out poling works on Tuesday 1st October 2024.

The alternative route for south west bound traffic will be to proceed in a north westerly then south westerly direction along the C2157 Rhandirmwyn, passing Troed Y Rhiw Hir and Fron Goch, to its junction with the A482 Crugbar. At the junction, turn left and continue in a southerly then south easterly direction along the A482 Crugbar, to its junction with the C2156 Llanwrda. At the junction, turn left and continue in a north easterly direction along the C2156 Llanwrda, to its junction with the C2164 Cilycwm. At the junction, turn right and continue in a south easterly direction along the C2164 Cilycwm, to its junction with the C2270 Cilycwm. At the junction, turn left and continue in a north easterly direction along the C2270 Cilycwm, to its junction with the C2157 Rhandirmwyn. At the junction, turn left and continue in a north easterly direction along the C2157 Rhandirmwyn to return to a point south west of the closure. Vice Versa for south west bound traffic.

Pedestrian movement to individual properties will be maintained where possible throughout the duration of the closure.
