Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic

Carmarthenshire County Council hereby gives notice that no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along that length of road known as the B4310 from a point 7.3 kilometres South West of its junction with the B4337 near the property Nantyffin, Brechfa (SA32 7RE) for a distance of 505 metres in a South Westerly direction.

The closure is necessary to ensure public safety whilst BT Priority Surveys restore customer services on Sunday 6th October 2024 for a period of one day. (Applicant:Bt Priority Surveys Tel 03700500792)

The alternative route for South West bound diverted traffic is to travel in a North Easterly direction along the B4310 through Abergorlech to Llansawel. At Llansawel Turn left onto the B4337 and proceed in a North Westerly direction through Rhydycymerau to Llanybydder. At Llanybydder turn left onto the A485 and proceed in a South Westerly direction through the villages of Llanllwni, New Inn, Gwyddgrug, Allt Wallis. The proceed in a Southerly direction through the villages of Pontarsais, Rhydargaeau, Peniel to its junction with the Glangwili Roundabout. At the roundabout take the first exit and proceed on the A485 towards Dolgwili Roundabout. At the Roundabout take the first exit onto the A40 and proceed in an Easterly direction through the village of Abergwili to Nantgaredig Square. At the junction turn left onto the B4310 and proceed in a North Easterly direction through the village of Felingwmuchaf, then in a North/North Easterly direction through the village of Brechfa to return to a point South West of the closure, Vice Versa for North Eastbound diverted traffic.

Pedestrian movement to individual properties will be maintained where possible

This Notice shall continue in force for a period not exceeding twenty-one days after which time its provision may be extended by a Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the same Act.
