




HOUSING

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Llanybydder, based on CACI's 2018 'PayCheck' data, is £24,128 which is the 18th lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 5.6% below the Carmarthenshire median of £25,488.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a lower than average level of people in higher/lower managerial and professional administrative occupations and intermediate occupations (Levels 1-3) and a higher than average number of small employers and own account workers (Level 4) and people in semi-routine occupations (Level 6).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2014 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2014 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Llanybydder 1** ranks 69 in Carmarthenshire from 112 LSOAs and is ranked 1052 in Wales from 1909 LSOAs. **Llanybydder 2** ranks 40 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 736 in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Llanybydder 1** is the Access to Services domain, being ranked 21st in Carmarthenshire and 143rd in Wales for this domain. In **Llanybydder 2** the Physical Environment domain is the most prominent ranking 7th in Carmarthenshire and 188th in Wales.
